Ashadeepa is a non-government organization, striving ceaselessly in the field of disability since 2004. Primary focus is to empower persons with disabilities to become active contributors to the society, through services of medical and physiotherapy intervention, rehabilitation, education, vocational and skill building & employment in retail and allied sectors. Organization also effort to solve domestic and dowry issues of aggrieved women by counseling and legal aid assistance through womenhelpline and Navajeevana old age home for aged women with specified intervention of medication, yoga & therapy.

OUR FLAGSHIP PROGRAMS

EARLY INTERVENTION & EARLY EDUCATION

Promote a child's age appropriate growth and development and support families during the early critical years. Ensure early detection, intervention, equal opportunities and social inclusion for the children.

PANKH-SKILL BUILDING & EMPLOYMENT

Program aims to develop a new strategic framework for Skill Development for the school dropouts and existing workers, especially in the retail and allied sectors in close consultation with Industries, Micro Enterprises in the informal sector. 1017 YwDs placed for jobs in retail and allied sectors.

SANTHWANA WOMEN HELPLINE- 1098

To provide counseling, referral and rehabilitative services to women and children who are the victims of atrocities and family maladjustment free of cost and working 24X7. Through counseling sessions the problem is diagnosed and efforts are made to reconcile families.

OUR IMPACT

Ashadeepa organization build an ecosystem for early stage intervention and early education in Hunagund and Ilkal Taluks covered 75 villages, 34 Panchayats in Bagalkot district. 532 children reached different stages of development milestone, become more functional physically to do self care and moment towards short distance they want to reach. 2515 domestic violence cases are solved by Women Helpline, and 14 cases in process.

Since inception, we have served over 54939 individuals under different projects and schemes.
